2. The Registered office of the Trust shall be situated at Maheshwar Bhawan, Chitragupta colony, Madhubani, Bihar- 847211 and it can/may be shifted to any other place (s) as may be decided by the Board of Trustees.

3. Umesh Kumar Ushakar S/O Sri Murli Dhar Yadav resident of at - Jatahi, P.O-Parsahi, P.S-Khutauna, Dist-Madhubani, Bihar, Pin code-847221 shall be the chief patron of the Trust.

4. Kumari Malvika D/O Sri Ram Dayal Yadav resident of at + P.O-Mirzapur, P.S-Ladaniya, Dist- Madhubani, Pin code 847232 shall be the permanent Managing Trustee. The founders of this trust shall be the permanent Trustees.

UMESH KUMAR USHAKAR S/O SRI MUR LIKHAR YADAV RESIDENT OF AT JATAHI, P.O-PARSABI, DIS-MADHUBANI & KUMARI MALVIKA D/O SRI RAM DAYAL YADAV RESIDENT OF AT + P.O-MIRZAPUR, P.S-LADANIYA MADHUBANI BIHAR. (HEREIN AFTER REFERRED TO AS THE FOUNDER OR AUTHOR OF THE TRUST WHICH TERM WHEREVER THE CONTEXT ADMITS OR PERMITS SHALL MEAN AND INCLUDE THE FOUNDER OF THE TRUST THEIR HEIRS, SUCCESSORS, ASSIGNEES AND LEGAL REPRESENTATIVES ESTABLISH THIS TRUST) ARE INTERESTED IN INDIAN CULTURE, VILLAGE SELF RELIANCE AND SUSTAINABILITY BASED ON THE PRINCIPLES OF EQUITY, EQUALITY, JUSTICE AND NON-VIOLENCE PROPOUNDED BY GANDHI, VIVEKANAND & JAY PRAKASH IRRESPECTIVE OF CASTE, CREED, RELIGION ETC, AND ARE DESIROUS OF PROVIDING MEANS AND MEASURES FOR THE WELFARE OF THE PUBLIC AT LARGE BY CREATING AND ESTABLISHING A PUBLIC CHARITABLE TRUST: AND WHERE AS with a view to and for the purpose of constitution of the Trust permanently as an irrevocable Trust, it is considered desirable that a declaration of Trust should be made in the manner set out hereunder:

5. The area of operation of this Trust shall be whole of the country wherever the demand as per aims and objects of the Trust arise.

6. The Authors of the Trust do hereby declare a sum of Rs 25000/- ( rupees twenty five thousand only ) contributed by them as Trust property and hereby transfers, assigns conveys and delivers unto the trust the said sum in cash, to have, own hold and stand possessed of the same in trust as trust fund which terms shall mean and include not only said sum declared as trust property, under these presents but also the additions and accretion to the investments for the time being representing the same for certain specified charitable objectives and accordingly, the Trustees hereby declare that they shall continue to hold the trust funds in Trust for these objective and purposes in accordance with the terms and condition contained in these presents.

7. AIM:

The Trust aims in making the society based on equality, justice and nonviolence, where human rights are most contained in every activity.

8. AIMS AND OBJECTS:

1. To prevent, arrest and reserve degradation of life support, particularly and water. So as to expand livelihood opportunities in equitable manner through people's participation.
2. To enquire study, develop & promote Indian systems of medicines viz. Ayurveda, Naturopathy, Yoga, along with Promotion, Projections & exhibition of medicinal/ herbal plants as well as Alternative Medicines and to conduct seminars & symposia to publish and distribute related institute for the awareness of the people and to meet the health centers with all facilities.
3. To organize and facilitate institutes and persons who are working in the field of Naturopathy, Yoga, Homeopathy & other systems of drugless therapies.
4. To establish, maintain and assist Centers & Institutes for research & development in the field of Naturopathy, Yoga, Homeopathy & other systems of treatment.
5. The society will work for the development of rural, urban and tribal area people under the rural development, sanitation development and problems of unemployment.
6. To Promote and undertake programme for moral and mental development of rural and urban area people of all communities in the field of education, run literacy programme and eradicate social evils among the society.
7. To work for the upliftment of women, child labour, bonded labour, untouchability, terrorism, drug-de-addiction, dowry system, prostitution, smoking, gambling and aware people in filed.
8. To establish, manage, maintain and run different type of technical and non-technical educational institutions reading rooms, common rooms, school, college, libraries, residential public school for the benefit of SC ST and general children and help to the meritorious students such time to time.
9. To undertake, organize and facilitate study centers, seminars, meetings, conferences, debates, workshops, rally, for the purpose and development of education, health awareness, sanitation, cultural development, socio

economic problem, pollution control, problem of unemployment and other social problems.

10. To help of the SC, ST, Dalit and deprived poor people time to time and provide financial help by the state and central government and other funding agency

11. To provide health-care facilities among the society and organize vaccination camp, Blood donation camp, mobile health care center, reproductive and child health camp, Indoor & outdoor patient care centers, women and child welfare programme

12. Relief measures among the society during the natural calamities like flood, fire, famine, earthquake, cyclone, drought and provide food, grain, medicine, treatment, and safe drinking water in remote area.

13. To run plantation programme, awareness programme and rural development programme and plant all types of tree for pollution control and protection of environment, give knowledge in non-conventional energy, solar energy and bio – gas and provide among the rural people.

14. To provide sanitation facilities, latrine, safe drinking water facilities, well and ponds drainage, culverts and bridge among the society and run building construction programme by the help of the state and central Govt.

15. To provide vocational training, First Aid Training, small scale industrial training, cottage industrial training, handicraft training, khadi and village industrial training programme for the benefit of rural women, men and handicapped people and run sewing, cutting, knitting, toy and doll making, preparation of jam and jelly, Madhubani painting, khadi and trained people for their self employment.

16. To run training center for the benefit of educated boys and girls like computer education, management education, accountancy education, journalism education, and its related works, typing, shorthand, electronic typing, electrical for their self employment and help to the SC/ST, Dalit, helpless and handicapped people.

17. To give knowledge to all kinds of people like consumer rights, information rights, formation and training of self help groups, Dalit human rights, panchayati raj, legal rights to women under the scheme of state and central Government and help to the rural people.

18. To provide irrigation facilities among the society in the area under the rural development programme and arrange boring, Tubewell, hand - pump under the scheme of Central Government.

19. To aware people in control of AIDS, Cancer, Kala-A-Zar, T.B. and Leprosy.

20. To print, publish, distribute reports, studies & brochures, souvenir and other publications pertaining to the activities of the Institute as well as to educate, inform & recreate the people.

21. To spread its activities by creating units at central, state, regional and districts/local levels.

22. To create, develop and promote scientific approach and activities, strengthen panchayati Raj Systems and promote its movement towards Gram Swaraj, encourage tourism aspects, develop & popularize Indian languages particularly Maithili, Hindi, Sanskrit, Indian culture & traditions among the youths and students.

23. To organize rural youth as youth Club & Mahila Mandal for their total development and through them for the development of rural society.

24. To organize leadership training and self employment training, Games, cultural, Yoga and adventure programmes and competitions, character building among youths.

25. To utilize youth energy for the successful execution of various development schemes of Government & Non Government Departments for rural and urban people.

26. To work for the reconstruction of the society on the principles and philosophy of Swami Vivekanand & Mahatma Gandhi.

27. To ensure human rights of its target group.

28. To create an awareness of physical, social and political environment to induce meaningful & constructive action.

29. To organize personality development camps, national integration camps for mass people particularly for students and youths.

30. To enquire, regulate, check, propagate and monitor the all governmental programmes especially related to health & to participate actively, to guard rights of information for the development of nation.

31. To start, promote, encourage and assist activities for economic, moral and social upliftment of rural people, of making unity and developing reciprocal cooperation between people and to implement khadi, and village industries programmes in particular for rural development and reducing poverty and for bringing better life style in rural people and for implementation of khadi and Village industries programmes to start, encourage and assist relevant and consistent activities.

32. To help poor and needy students with financial assistance for furthering their studies.

33. To create among the rural population the consciousness of environment and ecological factors conducive to healthier life for themselves and also of irrecoverable consequences resulting from ecological imbalances.

34. To help farmers, rural artisans, agricultural laborers by providing them integrated services and facilities for increasing employment, production and by organizing services for distribution of agricultural and consumer goods.

35. To do all such other things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects or any of them.

36. To give, grant or receive a financial assistance either by way of contribution or loan with or without any security to any person, bodies or agencies upon terms, which will ensure that the moneys (in cash or kind) are used for the attainment of the objects and purposes of the Trust.

37. In the course of the execution of any charitable Trust or purpose to purchase, take on lease or in exchange, hire or otherwise acquire any real or personal property and any rights or objects and to construct, maintain and alter any Building-(s) or erection (s) necessary or convenient for the work of the Trust.

38. To Sell, let mortgage, dispose of a term to account all or any of the property or assets of the trust as may be thought expedient with a view to the promotion of its objects.

39. To borrow or raise money for the purposes of the Trust on such terms and on such security as may be thought fit.

40. To establish and support or aid in the establishment and support of any charitable association or institution and to subscribe money for charitable purpose in any way connected with the purpose of the trust or calculated to further its objects.

41. To apply for or to receive or accept subscription, donation, contribution, aid from any person, institution, Bank or local authorities or khadi and village industries commission and or state commission Board and or institution or Union/state Government.

42. To acquire any land, building and movable or immovable property and gift, purchase, transfer or lease property and/or any interest by any other legal means to further any or all objects of the trust.

43. To construct, maintain, alter, extend, repair, reconstruct a building or house or a part there of and arrange and fit lights, water, drainage, furniture, fixtures, tool, equipments and other such things to the building to be used or is possessed.

44. To acquire on lease or by purchase or deal otherwise and to sell by mortgage, lease off, or transfer in any other manner, and to manage, exchange, pledge, hypothecate, demise or otherwise create a lien over the assets of the Trust whether movable or immovable for the purposes of the Trust.

45. To establish branch (es) of the Trust and to conduct it and do other needful to run the branches (es) and to take responsibilities of its activities to further the objects (s) of the Trust.

46. To provide legal assistance and free legal aid to poor.

47. To amalgamate or to take over the management of any other public charitable institution, project, branch of any institution on such terms and condition as the Trust think fit and to manage such institution.

48. To make or to become members of any institution or any statutory body towards promotion of Trust objects.

49. To do all such other thing as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects of any of them or for the general well being of the society and uplift of the social economical, cultural or economic development of the masses.

9. The income and property of the Trust, whensover derived, shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the Trust and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise however by way of profit, to the trustees or members of the trust PROVIDED that nothing herein contained shall prevent the payment in good faith of reasonable and proper remuneration to any officer or servant of the Trust or to any member or Trustee of the Trust in return for any service actually rendered to the Trust nor prevent the payment of interest on money lent or reasonable and proper rent for premises demised or let by any other trustee or member or the Trust.

#### 10. INTERPRETATION

In these Rules, unless the context otherwise requires, words or expressions defined in the Act or in any statutory modifications or reenactment thereof shall have the meaning as defined, words imparting the singular shall include the plural and vice-versa subject to the above the following words or terms shall bear the meaning set opposite to them hereunder:

"Act" means THE INDIA TRUSTS ACT, 1882.

"The trust" means DR. MALVIKA USHAKAR FOUNDATION TRUST (MUFT)

"The General Body" means the founder trustees and other trustees holding office till date including the chief patron

"The trust Board" means the founder trustees that is the Governing Body Executive body.

"The Trustee" means the founder member and new entrant trustee (s) under this rule of Trust"

"Committee (s)" means the committee (s) appointed by the Trust Board for any particular purpose (s) of the Trust.

"The Khadi" means' any cloth, woven in India on handloom using hands and also utilizing handspun cotton, silk and wool yarn or any two or all.

"The village Industries" means the village industries defined under section 2(H) of khadi and village industries commissions, 1956.

"The year" means the period beginning on 1<sup>st</sup> April of a year and ending on 31<sup>st</sup> March of the next year.

"The person" means individual, institution, society, bank, club, and Association, Corporation, corporate bodies/unit (s) and /or trust.

"The office bearers" means the chief patron, Managing Trustee and Treasurer of the trust.

11. TRUSTEES, GENERAL BODY, BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND ITS CONSTITUTION:

#### 11.A) MEMBERSHIP

11.Ai) Those who are signatories to the trust deed and remains members there of shall be the founder members.

11.Aii) Other persons who shall have attained the age of majority and who endorses the objects of the trust at recommendation Board of Trustees and with the approval of the chief patron be appointed as a trustee of the trust.

11.A.iii) All members shall be khadi-wearer(s)

## **11.B) TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP**

A member shall cease to be trustee of the trust in any of the following events:

11.B.i) his death, his becoming incapable, Lunatic or insolvent or convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude.

11.8ii) upon a member failing to attend three consecutive meetings (except in the case of founders and the chief patron) or observe any Rules, regulations, rulings, resolution or decision of the trust and or if a trustee acts against or which is detrimental to the interest of the trust, and a resolution having been passed by a majority of 2/3 members of the General Body that such member shall cease to be a member, provided that before a resolution is passed, an opportunity shall be given to the member concerned to appear and explain his position with regard to point in issue at a meeting of the Board of Trustees at which resolution is to be moved but that in the event of his not availing of the opportunity, the meeting not accepting his explanation, there shall be no question with regard to the validity and effectiveness of a resolution passed.

### 11.C GENERAL BODY

11.c.i) All trustees will constitute the General Body of the Trust, in addition to any other meeting the trust shall, each year have an Annual General Body Meeting of the Trustees of the Trust having right to attend and vote. The Annual General Body meeting of the Trust shall be held not later than six months from the dates of the financial year of the Trust.

11.c.ii) At the Annual General Body Meeting, apart from any other item of business set by the Board of Trust; the following business shall be transacted:

11.c.(ii).a) Consideration and adoption of the audited accounts of the Trust, the Annual Report to the Board of Trustee regarding the working of the Trust and consideration and approval of Budget of the following year.

11.c. (ii). b) Election, when due, as per Rules here of the members of the Trustees.

### 11.D. Board of Trustees

11.D.i) The management and control of the affairs of the Trust shall vest in the Board of Trustees which shall administer and control the funds of the Trust and shall consist of a Chief patron, a Managing Trustee, a Treasurer and minimum ~~three~~ other members including the founder permanent Managing Trustee,. In case, the founder permanent Managing Trustee ceases to be a trustee of the Trust anyway, the General Body will elect a Managing Trustee.

11.D.ii) The Board of Trustee shall have the powers to delegate all or any power vested in them by those documents to any committee or to any other trustee or to any other person for the purpose of conveniently managing and exercising such powers.

11.D.iii) Board or Trustee shall be elected for 5 (five) years terms. All members will be eligible for re-election.

11.D.iv) The number of the trustees in the Board of Trustees (including the permanent Managing Trustee) at no time shall fall below 5 (five) and exceed 15 (fifteen).

11.D.v) In case the office of a member of the Board of Trustee becomes vacant, it may be filled by the Board provided that in such case the appointment shall be valid until the next immediate Annual General Meeting. The working term of such appointed member will be equal to the remaining period against whom he has been appointed member will be equal to the remaining period against whom he has been appointed.

11.D.vi) The Board of Trustee may, in respect of any matters not hereby expressly provided for, from time to time, make such rules with regard to the conduct of the business or management of the affairs of the Trust as they may think proper or necessary for the discharge of their duties from time to time with power to add or alter, amend, abridge or substitute or delete any provisions of such rules.

11.D.VII) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEE WILL PERFORM THE FOLLOWING WORKS:

11.D.vii.a) To appoint, promote, penalize, suspend or discharge the duties or the personnel of the Trust and frame the rules and regulations of their services.

11.D.vii.b) To receive, deposit amount with security or without security and also to frame such conditions upon which they could be accepted and provide adequate protection for that.

11.D.vii.c) Purchase of raw materials, instruments and tools and sale of produced goods as well as making arrangements for storage of finished products.

11.D.vii.d) To fulfill the aim and objects of the Trust and organizing and conducting khadi and village industry production and processing and production of other village industries.

11.D.vii.e) production of instruments and tools and their maintenance and impart training to present members and others as well as improvement of production procedure.

11.vii.f) To ascertain the audit/verification of all Trust assets at least once a year.

11.D.vii.g) To insure the Trust assets.

11.Dviii.) The Board of Trustee shall meet as and when a meeting is convened by the Managing trustee or is requisitioned by at least 2/3<sup>rd</sup> of total members of the Board.

11.D.xi.) There shall be minimum two meetings of the Board in a year.

11.D.x.) Following the dates of adoption of the rules of the Trust, the remaining six members of Board of Trustee co-opted by the founders with the consultation of the chief patron as per these Rules:

#### 11.E.) POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE OFFICE BEARERS:

##### 11.E.1.) CHIEF PATRON

11.E.1.a) The Chief patron or in his/her absence the Managing Trustee shall normally preside at the meetings of the Trust.

11.E.1.b) The chief patron shall perform and carry out and exercise all powers, duties and function as the Board of Trustee may assign to him from time to time and exercise all such powers, privileges and discretion and all such cases, matters and things as may be necessity or convenient for the administering the general policies and promoting the objects of the Trust.

11.E.1.c) In case of equality of votes, the Chief patron or his/her substitute as the case may be presiding at the meeting in addition to his own vote shall have a casting vote.

##### 11.E.2 MANAGING TRUSTEE:

11.E.2.a.) The Managing trustee shall convene meetings and enter the resolutions in proceeding Books.

11.E.2.b.) The Managing Trustee shall cause and shall initiate other trustees to keep all records of accounts and other documents, registers in proper way.

11.E.2.c.) The Managing Trustee shall do all correspondences in general matters of the Trust.

11.E.2.d.) The Managing Trustee shall receive, distribute and expend all the funds of the Trust. For the promotion of its charitable objects.

11.E.2.e.) The Managing Trustee shall perform and carry out and exercise all powers, duties and functions as the Board of Trustee may assign to him and exercise all such powers. Privileges and discretion and do all such acts, matters and things as may be necessary or convenient for administering the general policies and promoting the objects of the Trust. ✓

**11.E.3) TREASURER**

11.E.3.a.) The Treasurer shall keep up-to date true accounts of all sums of money received and expended by the Trust.

11.E.3.b.) The Treasurer shall perform carry out the functions and exercise powers as the Board of Trustee may assign to him from time to time.

11.E.3.c.) The Treasurer shall raise funds for the Trust.

## 12. MEETING NOTICE

12.a.) Routine Meeting – A notice of 21 clear days for holding of General Body and Body of Trustee Meetings shall be sent to all members in question along with a statement of business to be transacted therein mentioning the time and place where such meeting is to be held.

12.b) Emergency Meeting-An emergency meeting can be convened on 3 (three) days notice.

### 13. QUORUM

The quorum necessity for all meeting shall be 2/3<sup>rd</sup> of the members of the Board of Trustee, General Body or of a committee as the case may be, in person or by proxy having the right to attend and vote. Any meeting suspended in want of quorum, shall be convened again wherein the quorum will not be binding.

## **14. PROXY**

A member entitled to attend and vote may be present in person or by proxy or by giving his decision to a proposal in writing by post. Only a member of the Trust be appointed a proxy by an instrument of proxy in the form to be prescribed by the Board of Trustee.

**15. VOTE**

Each member having right to attend and vote shall have one vote whether present in person or by proxy. In event of equality of votes, the chief patron or his/her alternate shall have a casting vote in addition to his own vote.

## 16. RESOLUTION

All decisions shall be taken by majority votes. A resolution signed by the majority of the majority of the Committee in question shall be as effective and binding as a resolution passed at a meeting of the said committee. The decision shall be exercised by way of resolution passed either by circulation or at the meeting.

**17. MINUTES**

That Managing Trustee, shall cause minutes of the meetings of the General Body, Board of Trustee and a Committee entered in the books kept for the purpose and the entry therein duly signed by the person presiding at the same or the next meeting shall prima facie be the evidence of the matters therein.

## 18. FUNDRAISING

The trust shall raise its funds from:

### 18 a) Admission fee, Membership fee and other fees.

18.b.) Donations, ~~subscriptions~~, Grants, interest, Dividends, Rents, Endowments, presents, Contributions, Gifts, etc, from members, public or from institutions.

18.c.) Borrowing on such terms of interest for a period as the board of trustee resolves.

18.d) To achieve the aim and objects of the trust to develop khadi and village industries. Arrange financial assistance from khadi and village

industries commissions or any other financial establishment set up by union and state Governments.

18.) Sale of Trust products, market networking and conducting schemes etc.

## 19. BANK . ITS OPERATION

The board of Trustee shall open accounts of any nature in any Bank of its choice in the name of the Trust and authorize operation of the said accounts by the members of the Board of Trustee provided that not less than two persons shall operate them jointly with an essential signature of the managing Trustee.

## 20. SUGGESTIONS REGARDING ITS PROPER FUNCTIONING

The Trust shall abide by the suggestions in matters of discharging personnel detrimental to the Trust in a project fully or partially financed by from KVIC. The Trust shall take prior permission before changing personnel from KVIC in a project financed by KVIC.

21.0) State Director of KVIC or any of its personnel may anytime inspect the book of account. Building, premises of the trust shall cooperate with them in their efforts.

21.p) Any contingency not covered by these rules may be decided upon by the General Body in such manner as it thinks fit.

21.q) Whenever it shall appear to the Board of Trustee that it is advisable to alter, extend or abridge such purpose (S) for which the Trust has been formed or to amalgamate the Trust, either wholly or partially, with any other society or the change the name and address of the Trust. The Board of Trustees shall submit its proposition to the members of the Trust and shall convince a special meeting for the consideration thereof according to the Rules of the Trust, but no such proposition will be carried into effect unless such report shall have been delivered or sent to every member of the society ten (10) days prior to the special meeting convened by the Board of Trustees for the consideration thereof nor unless such proposition shall have been agreed to by the votes of 3/5 the of the second special meeting of the month after the former meeting.

21.r) The rules and regulation harem contained may be amended, allotted or modified at any time by a two third majority at a general body meeting of the Trust duly convened in accordance with the provisions of the trust.

21.s) The office of the trustees off the Trust, shall be honorary and any person holding such office shall not be entitled to draw any remuneration for carrying out his duties but shall be entitled to be paid his actual traveling expenses and other incidental charges incurred by him for attending to the work of the Trust, however, if a trustee devote full time to the affairs of the trust the Board of Trustee may consider some remuneration or honorarium.

21.t) The trust shall such or be sure in the name of the managing trustee in courts or before any other authorities and departments of the governments, semi governments, local authority or any other statutory body in respect of trust matters in Madhubani itself.

## 22) DISSOLUTION

The trust shall have perpetual succession by its corporate name, but if in the course of time should be a dissolution of the trust, and if at that time, there shall have remained, after the satisfaction of the trustee just debits, liabilities any assets or property, movable or immoveable of any nature whatsoever, the same shall not be paid out to or distributed among the members of the trust or any of them, but shall be given to some other society, trust or institution having objects similar to those of this trust.
